# REFLECTIONS FROM FR. MATTHEW

## "If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all."

The first reading (Wis 2:12,17-20) shows the difference between earthly and heavenly wisdom. Earthly wisdom brings envy and selfish ambition, while heavenly wisdom brings peace righteousness. We can learn from this reading that true wisdom is not always appreciated. Sometimes, doing the right thing brings challenges and hardships. However, we are called to remain faithful and trust that God sees and knows our struggles. We should seek wisdom that brings righteousness, and a closer relationship with God. Staying true to this wisdom, even when it is hard, is our call as Christians.

The second reading (James 3:16-4:3) from the Letter of James speaks about the conflicts that arise from selfish desires. James urges us to seek peace and righteousness instead of giving in to jealousy and selfish ambition. He reminds us that true wisdom comes from God and leads to good deeds. Righteous living means putting God's will above our own desires. It involves seeking peace, being gentle, and showing mercy. These actions reflect God's wisdom and bring harmony into our lives and communities.

The Gospel of today (Mark 9:30-37) tells of the apostles arguing about who is the greatest. It is disheartening to see when Jesus again was reminding them what we heard last week, that he is going to suffer and die, they were arguing among themselves who is the greatest among them. They could not understand why Jesus should suffer and die because they were concerned about worldly ways, ways that say the powerful win and the lowly lose, the rich get rewarded while the poor suffer. Not so, Jesus says. In God's kingdom, "if anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all."

Jesus teaches them that true greatness comes from being humble and serving others. He uses a child to illustrate that we must welcome and care for those who are seen as least important. This passage shows that comparing ourselves to others leads to jealousy and ambition. Instead, we should appreciate our own unique gifts and use them to serve God and others. Humility helps us value ourselves and others without competition.

**WALK WITH ONE** invites **You** to evangelize one on one. Here's how you can respond:

- 1. Identify Spend time in prayer, asking the Holy Spirit to show you whom he wants you to accompany.
- 2. Intercede Pray for the person and for the grace to accompany them well
- **3.** Connect Build a relationship rooted in compassion. Listen to their story. Share your own. Walk alongside them, offering the support they need.
- 4. Invite Whether it's inviting them to join you for Mass, a small group, or a service opportunity, the Holy Spirit will lead you in guiding the person he wants to call home to Christ and his Church.
