- Bereavement: When the spouse of the bereaved is still alive and in the area, whenever possible the sympathy card will be delivered in person by a Minister of Care instead of mailed.
- Egg prices are going up so anyone who provides hard boiled eggs for St. Ben's or does a large amount of baking for any of the groups we work with, has been offered compensation from the Outreach budget. So far all have declined the offer.
- MPH Site becoming more handicap accessible work continuing; very expensive, grants will be investigated.
- Recent Spotlights:
  - January's Spotlight on the Women's Care Center went very well with 2 loads of items and one delivery of financial donations. They were very appreciative and after discussion with them and at the HCC meeting, future drives will be in the summer months when their need is greatest.
  - A.R.K. projects ran very well and brought excellent feedback from organizers, recipients, bakers, and those who delivered for Valentine's Day. Leftover grant money was used to purchase materials for next year and to finance the event on Shrove Tuesday for seniors and volunteers in multiple ministries.
  - Future A.R.K. Outreach will include Allis Care Center at Easter with Adult Confirmation candidates providing cards for residents, and to Veterans near Veteran's Day.

  - March "10 hour Adoration" HCC members will attend when able vs. a specific time due to work and volunteer schedules.
  - The HCC is sponsoring a table at the SSND Women's Leadership Luncheon on Alzheimer's.
